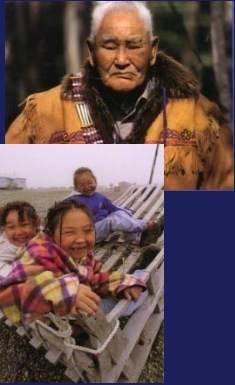

What a wonderful Saviour is Jesus our Lord! Hoping you all are doing well. This has been an exciting year for us so far, and we are looking forward to what the Lord will do.

In Revelation we read, "I know thy works: behold, I have set before thee an open door, and no man can shut it: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name." It is encouraging to know, God is still opening doors! He did not stop with Philadelphian church. He is willing and able to make a way for me and for you, if we will keep His word and not deny His name.

It is a great joy to report several more churches that have joined our Support Team: Temple Baptist in Collinsville, VA; Grace Baptist in Newport, NC; Houston Road Baptist in Troutman, NC & Zion Hill Baptist in Bluefield, VA.
It is a blessing to be fellowlabourers with them in a joint effort to reach lost souls for Christ.

As some of you know, I have been in contact with missionaries and pastors in Alaska since we began deputation. This has been an effort on my part to stay connected with our field, and those already labouring there. **Just recently, I received word that there is a remote village in the Southwest area (where God has called us), that needs a preacher.**

I am planning a trip to visit this village during the month of April. I feel God is leading me to do this. I want to remain sensitive to the will of God, whatever that might be. I have said all along that, "Whenever God says it is time to go, we are going to go." If this is that time, then by the grace of God, I am ready.

Please pray for me. I need the wisdom of God to make the right decision.

The community I will be visiting is near other native villages that can be reached with the gospel. It would be my desire to see these evangelized and bible-believing Baptist churches established.

This will be excellent experience for me, especially since I have yet to visit the area of AK where God has called us to, among the Yupik people.

If you have not been to our website lately, please check out some of the new things we have posted there. **We have a new section on our site dealing with "Operation Care Package"** – we would like to get more churches and families personally involved with our ministry, when we get to the field. By having items shipped to us in Alaska, it will save us a great deal of money, since everything is at least 2-3 times the cost in remote Alaska as it is in the Lower 48. If enough interest is generated, and enough folks commit to sending us a package once a year, we would not have to raise as much monthly monetary support.
