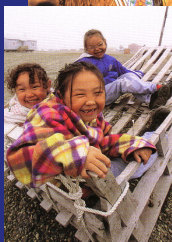
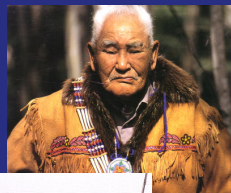

They were able to give us good counsel, and illustrations of what Native ministry will be like.

As mentioned in our previous letter, the Lord has burdened my heart for the Yupik people in Southwest Alaska. God has used one of our slides to confirm His leading to this area. It was really neat how God did this, I had seen this slide over and over many times, but it wasn't until I sought the Lord that He opened my eyes, and I saw what He wanted me to see.

In Alaska news, we were told about a 30 year-old man from the Catholic village of Kaltag, who was incarcerated in Anchorage. One evening he observed his cell mate reading a book and asked what he was reading, and if it was a "good read". It was a Bible. He heard the gospel for the first time and was saved, but **in 30 years had never seen a Bible!** How many more Native Alaskans are there who have never heard a clear presentation of the gospel?
